1. PURPOSE

To identify and communicate the University Parallel (General Studies) Program Evaluation Model.

2. SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

All locations and employees of Southern.

3. DEFINITIONS

The terms “General Studies Program” and “University Parallel Program” have the same meaning and refer to a program of study designed to enable a student to obtain approximately two years of general study courses for transfer to a four year baccalaureate program.

4. POLICY

The General Studies (University Parallel) program will be regularly reviewed, evaluated, and revised as needed by Division Chairpersons named herein in accordance with governing board policy.

6. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. The General Studies (University Parallel) program shall include all disciplines clustered under the Humanities, Natural Sciences and Social Sciences divisions.
- B. The General Studies (University Parallel) program shall be staffed by members of the Faculty whose major teaching assignments are generic to the Divisions/disciplines as follows:
