Paramedic Preceptor Policy

Adopted: October 2018 Revised: November 2019 (WVOEMS)

<u>Purpose:</u> Students are required to complete a clinical and field internship serving as team leader in a variety of emergency and non-emergency situations.

<u>Field:</u> Students will choose three preceptors that have been approved by the program coordinator, medical director and/or squad training officer.

<u>Hospital:</u> The student reports to the charge nurse. The charge nurse will designate an RN preceptor for the shift. The RN preceptor will evaluate the student and sign the clinical sheet.

<u>Preceptor Responsibilities:</u> -performance evaluation and training of paramedic students during their internship

- -Interns will be directly supervised and mentored by an approved preceptor.
- -Meet with coordinator as needed for consultation concerning student performance.
- -Review all preceptor training material to stay updated on changes or updates.
- -Attend the annual Advisory Meeting to review new/updated policy to stay current with changes and updates.

Preceptor Approval/Qualification: Preceptor candidates must submit the following to Southern.

- -A preceptor application
- -A copy of a current WV certification
- -Certification must be in good standing with no incidents
- -Successful completion of a Preceptor Training Workshop and/or individual training
- -For the field...prior experience in teaching/preceptor methodology may be substituted for the Preceptor Training

Preceptors should demonstrate the following characteristics:

-A desire to teach.

-Willing to be a preceptor.

-A non-judgmental attitude.

- -Flexibility to change and adapt to new situations
- -Excellent communication skills
- -Positive attitude toward good patient care
- -Critical thinking and interpersonal skills
- -Above all...Patience

<u>Preceptor Agreement</u>: Agrees to accept one paramedic intern for semester for intern practical skills and patient care. -Agrees to allow the student to serve as team leader in a variety of emergency situations performing advance life support techniques while under the direct observation of the preceptor. -Agrees to complete evaluations of the student in professional and fair manner for proper grading of the student's performance. -Remain with the student throughout the assessment and treatment of the patient. -Understand the students will evaluate the preceptor at the end of the rotation.

Preceptor status may be revoked at any time based on evaluations from students and/or department heads. Name
