- 1. Students will identify the various work areas within the Central Sterile Process department and recognize the roles of patient care.
- 2. Demonstrate the roles and responsibilities of the Central Sterile Technologists within the department.
- 3. Students will differentiate between decontamination, inspecting, assembling, packaging, and processing both common and complex surgical instruments.
- 4. Maintain documentation required by the accrediting agencies for quality control and log a minimum of 400 hours of Central Sterile Technician clinical hands-on experience.
- 5. Demonstrate knowledge of medical and surgical instrumentation, supplies, and equipment in various specialties.
