 - Regional Business News** offers information from 80 full text regional business publications from metropolitan and rural areas of the U.S.
 - MasterFile Premier** offers our students/faculty 1,700 full text periodicals dating back to 1975, with 500 reference eBooks and over 164,000 primary sources documents. It is a general database good for any class.
