For the purpose of taking into consideration Southern's academic calendar, holidays indicated as "Alternate" are in lieu of the Year 2021 Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, and Year 2022 President's Day, Lincoln's Day, Primary Election Day, Memorial Day, and West Virginia Day.

If any additional holidays are declared by the President of the United States, the Governor of the State of West Virginia, or the West Virginia Legislature during the 2021-2022 fiscal year, the Classified Staff Council suggests moving those days to the week of Spring Break in 2022.

<u>REVISION TO SCHEDULE 12/13/2021</u>: On Tuesday, December 7, 2021, Governor Justice issued an executive order declaring the last half of the days of Thursday, December 23, 2021 and Thursday, December 30, 2021 as work releases for all public employees of the state without charge against accrued annual leave. Since these days were not declared holidays but releases from work, these ½ days must be taken on the designated days. Therefore, Southern will observe the ½ day work releases on Thursday, December 23, 2021 and Thursday, December 30, 2021, along with ½ day holidays in lieu of Lincoln's Day. Southern will then observe one full day on Monday, March 14, 2022, during Spring Break, in lieu of Primary Election Day.
