Spirit of Logan Scholarship Application

Overview

The Spirit of Logan Scholarship was created in 2024 through a partnership between the Southern West Virginia Community College Foundation and our Logan, West Virginia friends. Logan holds a special place in the hearts of many who have lived and worked here. With its deep roots in rich traditions and mountain heritage, Logan was once a hub for coal mining, a vital industry that fueled the steel production used to build the nation. This scholarship is dedicated to helping students cover tuition and other educational costs. It honors the legacy of Logan Countians by providing a means for one generation to give back to another, helping those who call southern West Virginia home, even those who have moved away.

Criteria

1. First preference is given to students enrolled in an education, allied health, or nursing program.
2. Must be a resident of Logan County, WV.
3. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher.
4. The award pays tuition and other educational-related expenses.
5. Students must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to be considered for this scholarship.

This is a “last dollar scholarship” designed to provide funds to those students who have an unmet financial need after applying for other sources of assistance. If a student receives a scholarship, it will be counted in determining his/her financial need and may be reduced if the scholarship, when combined with other sources of assistance, more than meets the student’s documented financial need. The scholarship may be renewable, based on student financial need (determined annually), program status, and funding availability.

Please fully complete the application and submit it to the External Affairs Office. This scholarship application will be kept on file for the current academic year. Incomplete applications may not be considered.

The priority deadline to submit this application is April 15 for Fall Semester and October 15 for Spring Semester. Applications submitted after the Priority Deadline will still be considered for any remaining scholarship funding. A completed application must be submitted for each academic year a student wishes to be considered for scholarships. **Only those selected for scholarships will be notified.**
